

We are counting down the days until we see you!

By now you should have received the following information, from either myself or Lara Wilbur, our principal:

- Teacher Letter and Supply List (newest placements, that's coming soon)
- Registration Information (All NEW students must register before August 24th)
- Tuition Information, first payment due August 24th (applies to ELC Tuition students only)

An Important Reminder: ELC students must be Nixa residents and must be FULLY potty trained before the first of school.

In our program, students must be able to independently recognize the need to use the restroom and complete the process on their own, from start to finish.

Getting ready for Orientation: (held next week, August 17th thru 21st)

- Teachers will be reaching out to you with specifics as we prepare for our 20/21 school year. We need you to know of some additional preparations.
- This year's first day of school will look different than in years past.
- Due to limitations to visitors to the building, parents will not be able to walk their children in the building and to class on the first day of school.
- We invite you to treat your time during Meet the Teacher as your first day of school!
- We ask that the student's guest be kept to a minimum.
- Mom and Dad or other main caregivers are welcome, but extra guests like aunts, cousins or grandparents etc., are asked to stay home. We discourage bringing siblings, if you are unable to find alternative care - please notify the teacher of how many people will be in your party, to allow for proper planning. Please keep visitors to 3 or less.
- All guests, with the exception of students of the ELC/ECC, will be required to wear a mask to enter the building.
- Upon entering the classroom, the student and any family members will be asked to wash their hands or use the classroom hand sanitizer. This allows us to demonstrate what will be expected of students later this month.
- You will also be asked to arrive at your scheduled start time, not earlier than needed to help reduce the number of people in the building.
- There will be limited time spent in the room to allow the teacher to be ready for the next student. Some teachers will be attempting to see 35 students in a matter of days.
